
This year's support has been the biggest ever of \$800.00. This is amazing and greatly appreciated. Hopefully in the next newsletter there will be a photo.

'Art by Marcelle' is the Solo exhibition from 15th Nov - 25th Nov by our Member artist Marcelle Weereratne. The exhibition presents a diverse display of artworks spanning almost a half-century, encompassing oils, watercolours, acrylics, pastels, and drawings. These pieces will showcase a wide range of styles and subjects, from realistic representations to abstract creations.

Marcelle, originally from Sri Lanka, has called Melbourne home since 1976. There, she honed her artistic skills under notable mentors like A.C.G.S. Amarasekera and her late uncle Neville Weereratne. Encouraged by family, teachers, and friends, she pursued Graphic Communications at Caulfield Institute of Technology, later part of Monash University. She has showcased her work in numerous exhibitions and was honoured with an Encouragement Award at the 2004 Herald Sun Rotary Art Show in Camberwell. Additionally, she provided illustrations to children's stories penned by other authors.
